REFUND POLICY—CODE WEEKEND

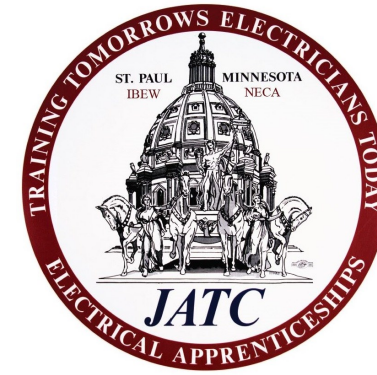
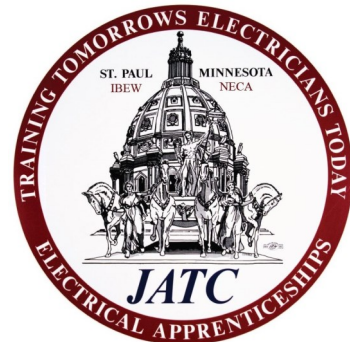
If you register for a weekend code class and do not show or cancel at least 5 days prior, you will not be reimbursed the \$20.00 intended for food.

The JATC OFFICE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE IF YOUR LICENSE EXPIRES. **If you have not been notified by the JATC two weeks prior to your requested class start date, it is your responsibility to contact our office.**

The JATC office along with the Electrical Licensing and Inspection Unit needs time to do the paperwork involved with crediting your class.
